### УКРЕПЛЕНИЕТО /Форт/ МЕДЖИДИ ТАБИЯ

Намира се южно от Силистра и е най- запазеният от шестте укрепителни пункта на обранителната система на града, изиграла важна роля в руско-турските воини от 1853-56 г. и 1877-78 г. Идеята за построяването на тази система от военни укрепления е дело на немския военен инженер Хелмут фон Молтке /по-късно началник-щаб на немската армия/, посетил Силистра през 1837 г. Крепостта е градена през периода 1841-1853 г. Строена е от принудително събрани 300 българи. Главните майстори са от Дряново, а каменоделци са от региона. По време на строителството на крепостта те строят и първите монолитни възрожденски храмове в Силистренско в Алфатар (1846 г.) и Калипетрово (1847 г.).

През 1847 г. е посетена от султан Абдул Меджид, проявил интерес към нея и по този повод тя е наречена на негово име - Меджиди табия. Крепостната стена има формата на шестоъгълник и достига на височина до 8 м. Непосредствено до нея има ров, служил едновременно за препятствие и маскировка. Крепостта е била завършена по времето на областния управител Саид паша в навечерието на Кримската война. Крепостта е атакувана от русите през Кримската война, която започва през 1853 г. с битката за Силистра. В сражението участва гениалният руски писател Лев Николаевич Толстой.

### FORTIFICATION /Fort/ MEDJIDI TABIA

The fort is situated in South of Siliстра and it is the most preserved of the six strengthening points of the defense system of the city, which plays an important role during Russian-Turkish wars in 1853-1856 and 1877-1878.

The idea for the construction of this system of military defenses is of a German military engineer Heinrich von Moltke (later head of the German army headquarters), who visited Siliстра in 1837.

The fortress is build during the period 1841-1853. For its construction is used the forced labour of 300 Bulgarians. The main masters are from Dryanovo and the stonemasons are from the region os Silistra. During the fortress's building, they build also the first monolythic renaissance temples in Silistra's region - in Alfatar (1846) and in Kalipetrovo (1847).

In 1847 the fortress is visited by Sultan Abdul Medji and its the reson for the name of the fortress - "Medjidi Tabia".

The fortress wall has a hexagonal form and it reaches a height of 8 m. Immediately in front of it there is a moat, used as an obstacle and as a camouflage simultaneously. The construction if the fortress is finished in the eve of the Crimean war. The Russian attack the fortress in 1853. In the battle participates the genial Russian writer Lev Tolstoy.


